

RULES OF ENGAGEMENT

- 1. Gentlemanly and gentlewomanly behaviour will be strictly observed at all times. Those from other towns will especially be expected to be on their best behaviour and act as an example to all participants.
- 2. Frying pans must NOT be used as weapons or as a means of making unseemly gestures, whatever the depth of provocation or the nature of the business of the person at the root of such provocation.
- The pancakes must not be propelled in the direction of other 3. participants or spectators As this may constitute assault and battering.
- The course is over 80 yards and pancakes must be tossed once 4. in each direction to a minimum height of 3 (three) feet each time, whilst the competitor is within the tossing zone.
- If a participant allows a pancake to fall to earth, he or she must 5. return to the starting line and begin the race again.
- Members from each team will run in relay and the pancake and 6. frving pan must be exchanged intact before the next member of the team can proceed.
- The organisers reserve the right to send off violent or unruly 7. participants.
- 8. The decisions of the Umpire, will be final whatever conclusions participant may themselves come to about their eyesight, hearing, bias or parentage.









Racing Gear – Anything goes except in relation to footwear. Competitors must wear shoes suitable for the task. There will be prizes for the best dressed team.

At the Start - The Starter will order the competitors: "Tossers - Are you ready?" And a Whistle will be blown as the racers start off. The pancakes must stay in the pans during the race. If they fall out, the racer must put the pancake back in the pan and must return to the start line and begin again.

At the Half way point and the Finish - After you reach the half way point and cross the finish line, she or he must toss their pancake into the air and catch it in the pan before being declared the winner.
